Finding Literary Criticism in the

Gale Literature Products

This tutorial will introduce the Gale Literature products, which are compilations of essays and articles on literary topics from a wide variety of sources.

The Gale Literature Series Index provides citations to the essays in all of the literature series that the Gale company publishes. Many of these Chambers library owns in print and has shelved in the Reference collection on the first floor of the library. But the Literature Series Index offers only citations that lead you into these print materials.

To get the full-text articles and essays online, we will use Gale Literature Resources and Gale Literature Criticism Online. Each of these resources provides complete articles and essays contained within a specific collection of Gale publications.

Literature Resources includes *Contemporary Authors*, selected articles from *Contemporary Literary Criticism*, the *Encyclopedia of Literature*, *Scribners Writers*, *Twaynes Author Series*, the *Dictionary of Literary Biography*, *LitFinder*, *Merriam-Webster's Encyclopedia of Literature* and *Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary*, and the *Gale Literary Index*.

Gale Literature Criticism Online offers all of the articles from the Gale criticism series that the company has been able to obtain permission to reproduce. We will begin searching here for criticism on the short story "Young Goodman Brown" by Nathaniel Hawthorne.
