### Finding Articles

All sources below are available from the library website (<http://library.uco.edu>) on campus and off campus with UConnect ID and PIN

Source	Contents
<i>America: History and Life</i>	Citations and abstracts for journals, book chapters and dissertations in American history
Ebsco <i>Academic Search Complete</i>	Contains full text of many of scholarly publications in all disciplines plus the popular press
Ebsco <i>Military &amp; Government Collection</i>	Contains full text for 320 periodicals pertaining to all branches of the military and government, as well as, abstracts for 350 magazines articles
<i>Project Muse</i>	Full text of selected scholarly periodicals primarily from Johns Hopkins University
<i>JSTOR</i>	Full text for 117 journals in the humanities, social sciences, and sciences. The most recent issues are 3-5 years from date of publication.
<i>Historical Abstracts</i>	Contains some full text on world history, military history, women's history, history of education, and more from the year 1450 to the present day.

**Tip:** Search by keyword first, then subject. Connect words with **and**, not with *in, on, from* or *of*.
