*Twentieth Century Literary Criticism*: Ref PN771 .G27 – Includes authors who wrote between 1900-1960.

*Contemporary Literary Criticism*: Ref PN771 .C59 – Includes authors who wrote after 1960.

*Nineteenth Century Literary Criticism*: Ref PN761 .N56 – Includes authors who wrote between 1800 - 1900.

*Literature Criticism from 1400 to 1800*: Ref PN86 .L56 – Includes novelists, poets, playwrights, and philosophers.

*Classical and Medieval Literature Criticism*: Ref PN610 .C5x – Includes criticism of literature written in during the Greco-Roman era and the Middle Ages.

*Poetry Criticism*: Ref PN1010 .P62 – Includes criticism of classical poetry through the twentieth century.

*Short Story Criticism*: Ref PN3373 .S5x – Includes major short story writers from all periods.

*Contemporary Authors*: Ref PS129 .C62x – Includes authors of fiction, non-fiction, poetry, and drama.

*Dictionary of Literary Biography*: Ref PS21.D5x – Includes criticism by genre.

*Dictionary of Literary Biography Yearbook*: Ref PS21 .D5bx – Includes obituaries of authors.

*Something About The Author*: Ref PN451 .S6 – Includes authors of children's books.

### **Magill Literary Criticism Series**

*Magill's Literary Annual*: Ref PN44 .M332x – Includes essay reviews of 200 outstanding books published in the U.S. during the previous year.

*Masterplots*: Ref PN44 .M33 1996 - previous edition - Ref PN44 .M33 1976 – Includes a collection of 500 plot summaries of novels, plays, poems, and non-fiction works.

*Masterplots II: Poetry Series*: Ref PN1110.5 .M37 1992 – Includes multi-cultural writers of the seventeenth century through the twentieth century.

*Masterplots II. Juvenile and Young Adult Fiction Series*: Ref Z1037 .A1 M377 1991-Includes essays on books published for readers age 10 to 18 years old.

*Critical Survey of Drama: English Language Series*: Ref PR623 .C75 1985 – Includes essays on individual dramatists, as well as, the development and production of English-language drama from the medieval period to the twentieth century.

*Critical Survey of Short Fiction*: Ref PN3321 .C7- Includes short fiction writers from antiquity to the twentieth century.
